# Floating Mirror

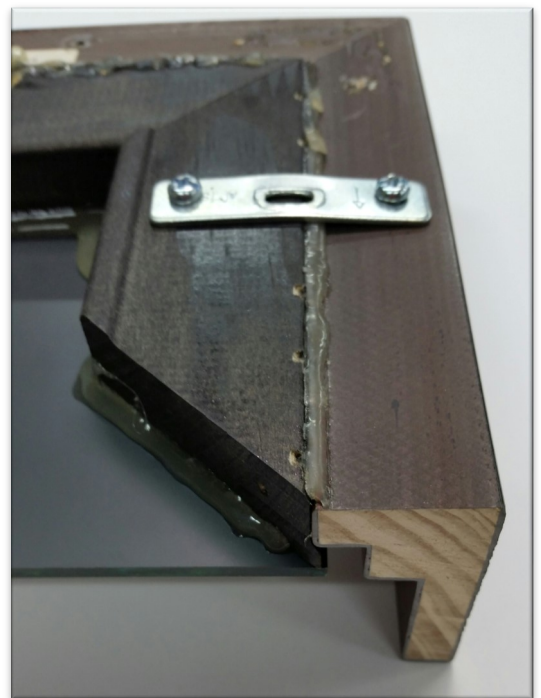
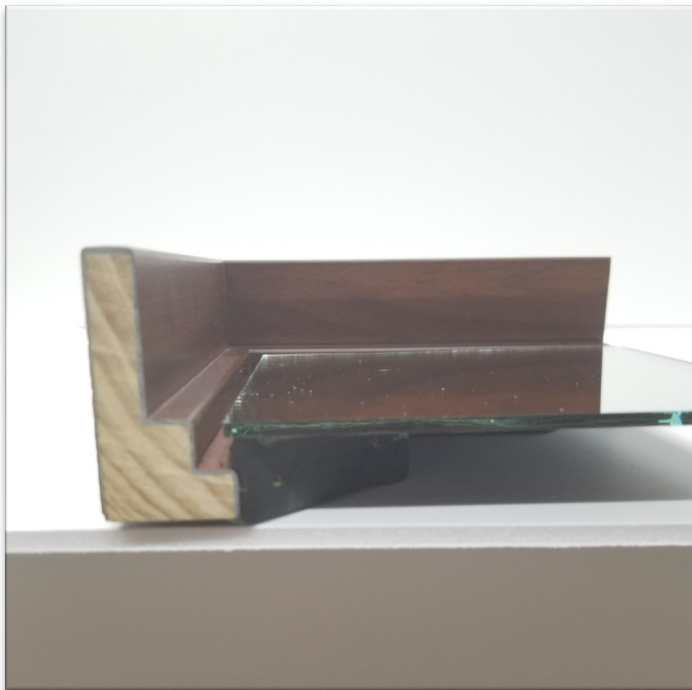
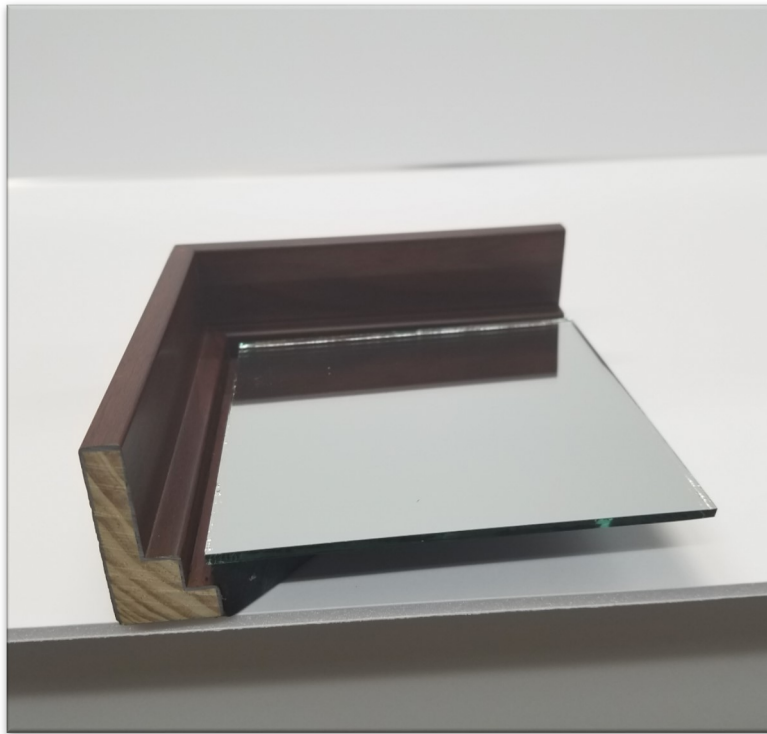
1. If using flat mirror-order polished edge. If beveled- the edges are polished as part of the beveling process.
2. The mirror can be level with the face of the floater frame or recessed. The gap between glass and frame can also vary from no gap up to about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " depending on the width of the frames lower leg.
3. For frames with a skinny lower leg, use a stretcher bar.



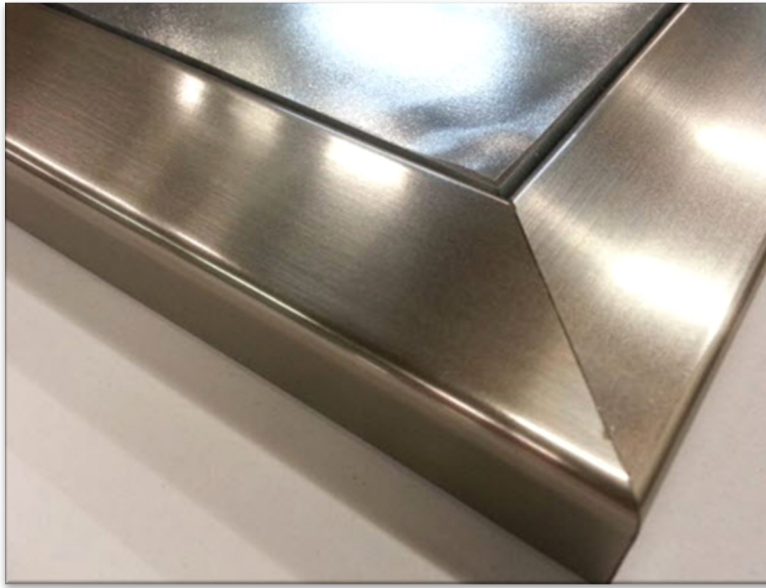

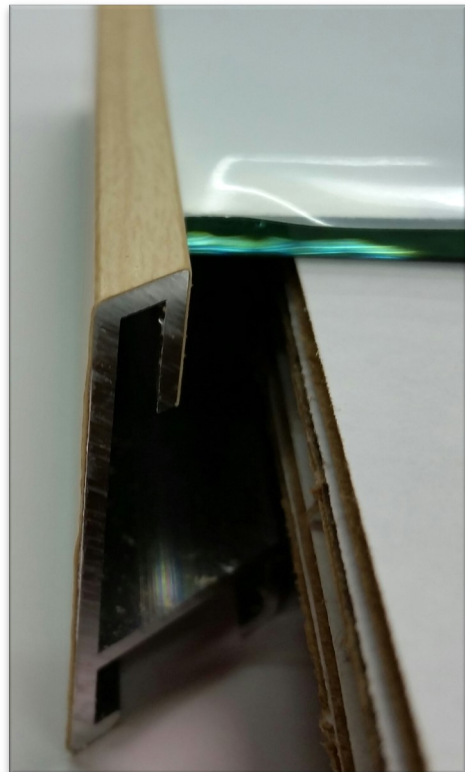
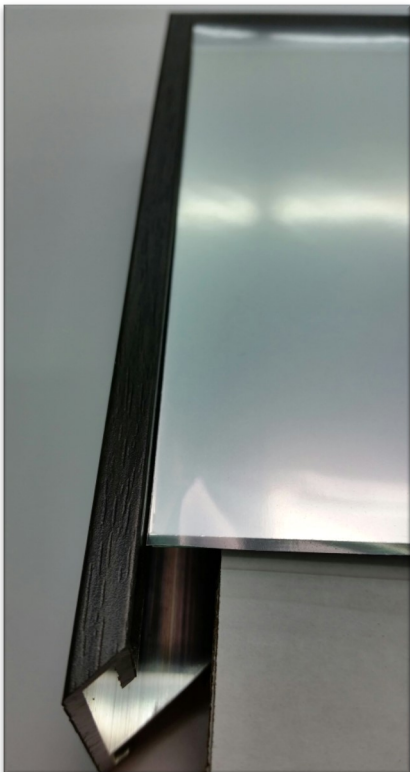
